- 1) Go to www.gcsepod.com and click “Login” in the top right-hand corner
- 2) Click “New here? Get started.”
- 3) Select “Student”
- 4) Enter your **name**, **date of birth** and **the school name**.
- 5) Create a **username**, **password**, and a **password hint** to help you remember the password.

Students have set up a login and password themselves. You can watch short podcasts that are really useful for all subjects.

<https://www.pixl.org.uk/> - this is a website that we subscribe to as a school to support with Maths, English Literature, History and Geography. The school ID is JP749, student username is their Surname & Initial (first letter caps) e.g. SmithA; then their First name (first letter caps) & 2019 e.g. Alice2019.

There are a wide range of multiple resources that students can use to practise for these subjects. For example, try the PiXL daily Maths challenge, which is great for a few minutes warm up each day.

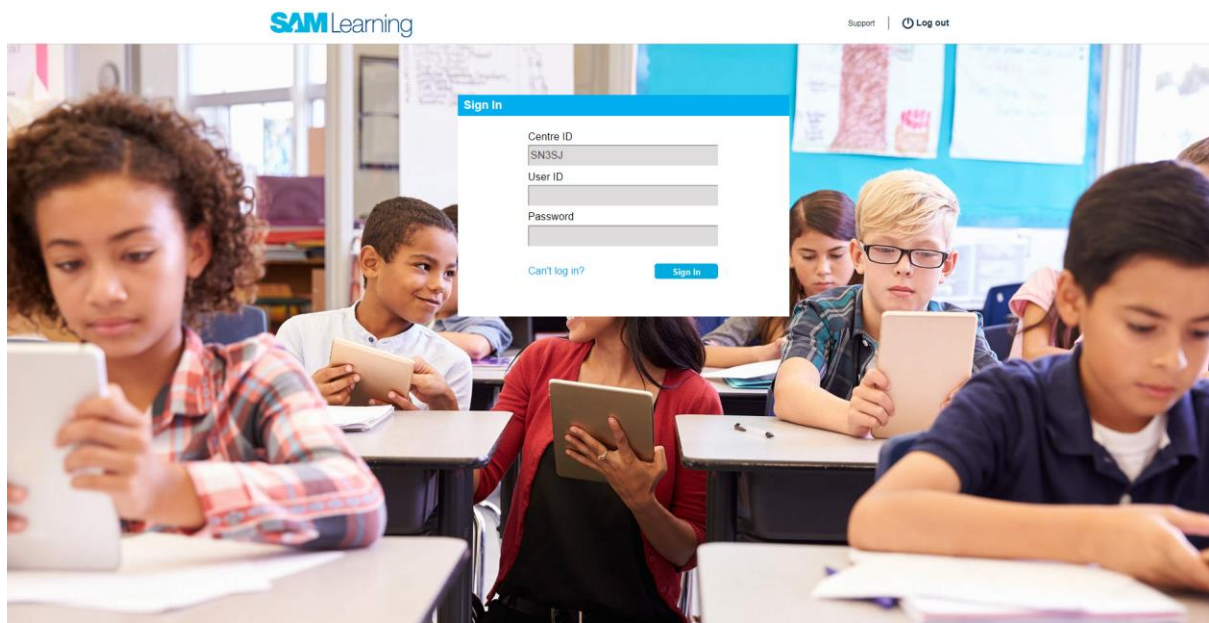

Excellent for Science, Maths and English students learn through quizzes and short videos, using our **mobile app** or other online devices. **Content** is broken down into bite sized chunks and **tailored to each user**, using an intelligent algorithm it works out what students know and where they need to focus their efforts. Students will set their own account up adding name, school email and the school access code, **WT1RRIS1**. Please see the instructions 'Tassomai Student Guide'.

- User ID & Password are the same – **6 digit date of birth plus capital initials** (no gaps) e.g. **120904AM**

Maths GCSE – Edexcel (Year 10) & AQA (Year 11)

www.mathswatch.org – this is a subscription website that has lots of videos as well as questions. Teachers will set students additional homework tasks via this site. To login they should go to the website and click on the link to the VLE. Students have been issued with their login details by their teacher. They are the first three letters of their first name and the first three letters of their surname@ stjosephs. Their password will be 'password', which they must change.

www.mymaths.co.uk – this is a subscription website, login is SJCC and the password is integer. Each student has their own individual login that they can use which scores them and tracks their achievement in each topic, but they can still access with the main password to complete lessons.

www.mathsmadeeasy.co.uk – this is a website that has a large number of practice papers that students can access. There are mark schemes and worked solutions, so that if they are stuck on a question, they can see the process that they should follow to complete it.
