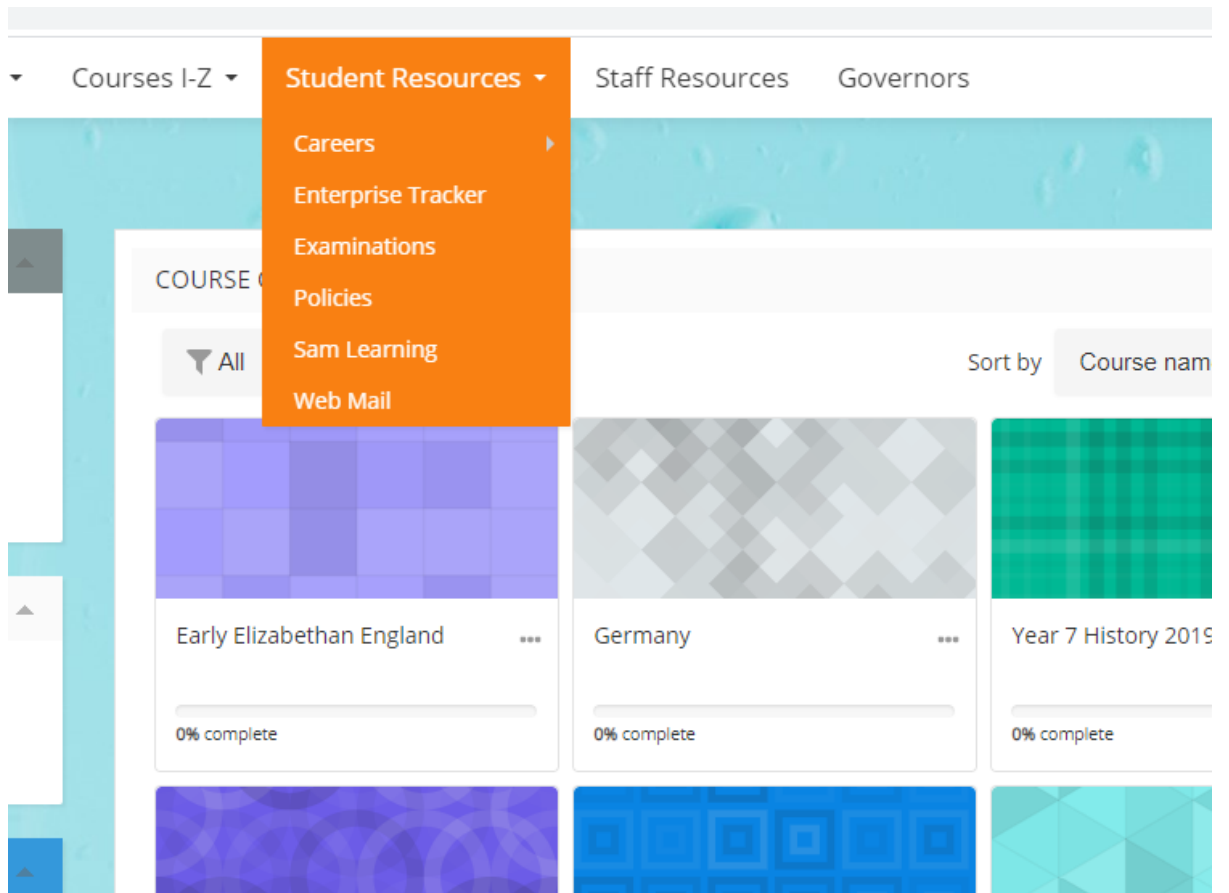
- To access Moodle. Launch a web browser. And enter the listed below URL.
